

OUR STANDING COMMITTEES And What They Do

AMERICANISM: This person would lead the club meetings in Renewal of the Pledge of Allegiance, and may occasionally present projects or historical information that foster patriotism. **BUDGET:** Budget Committee works with the Treasurer to

review the budget and propose amendments, to be voted on by the Board of Directors for approval each year.

BYLAWS: The Bylaws Committee reviews the bylaws each biennial to propose amendments and to ensure all CFRW/NFRW amendments have been incorporated. Amendments not mandatory from CFRW/NFRW will be voted on by the Board of Directors for approval each biennial.

CAMPAIGN/CENTRAL COMMITTEE:

The Campaign/Central Committee Chairman shall keep the Club informed of activities of our County Central Committee and of opportunities for participation in candidate campaigns, voter registration campaigns and other community activities in keeping with our mission.

CARING FOR AMERICA/ARMED FORCES: This program is based on the belief that problems can be solved most effectively through the generosity and combined energies of individual citizens. The Caring for America/Armed Forces Committee Chair shall develop a project or projects which assist our communities to flourish. Recently, for example, we have the NextDoor Solutions women's shelter, encouraged donations for the CFRW's Young Americas Foundation that sends young Republicans for education at the Reagan Ranch.

FINANCIAL REVIEW: This committee reviews the West Valley RWF treasury books twice annually to ensure all is in order.

HISTORIAN: The Historian shall gather and assemble information, such as event photos, newsletters, etc. covering each year to be included in the Club's History display (via scrapbooks, storyboards, etc.) The Club History Book or boards shall be displayed occasionally during the year and at events.

HOSPITALITY: The Hospitality Chairman shall be responsible for setting monthly lunch menu options, accepting RSVPs and checks, and greeting members and guests at meetings and events. She shall perform other tasks as requested by the President.

LEGISLATION: Follow CFRW Legislation Updates and report at cub meetings on any Action Alerts to our members so that they can participate in promoting or stopping legislation.

MEMBERSHIP: This committee works with our 2nd VP to help grow our club through outreach via calls, letters and/or publicity. **NEWSLETTER:** The Chairman shall be responsible for the publication of the Club's newsletter with input from the President and/or designated Board members. Complimentary copies shall be sent at the direction of the President.

PHONE TREE: The Chairman shall establish and maintain a telephone/e-mail committee for contacting the entire membership as may be required, at the direction of the President, to advise on General Meetings, Action Alerts or Emergency notices.

PUBLICITY/SOCIAL MEDIA/WEBSITE: The Chairman shall be responsible for publicizing activities of the Club via news releases to newspapers, Facebook or Twitter and via our Club newsletter.


