TRUMP'S WARNING

Many people are confused by Trump's sudden interest in the Panama Canal and Greenland, but his purpose is deadly serious.

Donald Trump has been making headlines recently with comments about the Panama Canal and Greenland. Many people are confused by his sudden interest in these countries.

He's addressing these issues in his typical Trumpian way, but his purpose is deadly serious. There is a simple five-letter answer to both: C-H-I-N-A.

Many people in Washington, D.C., believe we are headed to a third world war with communist China and its allies — Iran, North Korea, and Russia. But we are not prepared for it.

Our weapons supplies would be <u>exhausted in days</u> because our industrial base has been hollowed out. As we have reported, wargame simulations regularly show us <u>losing</u> to communist China and suffering "horrifically bloody" losses in the simulations we do win.

The Canal

In any global conflict, the Panama Canal and Greenland are vital strategic assets. The Panama Canal is more important than ever with Middle East sea lanes under attack by <u>Iranian proxies</u>.

In his Christmas message, Trump referred to the Chinese troops illegally operating the canal. He's referring to the fact that Chinese companies, almost always connected to the Chinese military, now control ports at both ends of the Panama Canal.

But the Panama Canal treaty requires that the canal remain "permanently neutral." Instead, one of the world's most important economic and military assets has been compromised by communist China.

U.S. military leaders have been warning for years that communist China's investments in South America put it "in the red zone" or "on the 20-yard line to our homeland." Many of the facilities Beijing is building in our backyard could quickly be converted to military bases.

My political career was formed by Ronald Reagan. In 1977, Jimmy Carter surrendered the canal that we built at great cost. Predictably, the entire political establishment of the United States couldn't wait to embrace that surrender except for one guy — Ronald Reagan. Sadly, the treaty was ratified.

But Middle America was furious, and the surrender of the Panama Canal was one of the major issues that contributed to Reagan's election in 1980. So, this is not some bizarre idea. It is something Ronald Reagan deeply believed in.

Joe Biden and the left are all in on standing with Ukraine on the border with Russia rather than educating the American people about the canal's strategic importance and what is going on right now in Panama.

Greenland

Communist China has had its sights set on Greenland for more than a decade. It has aggressively courted the sparsely populated, semi-autonomous island with promises of foreign investment. In return, the Danish embassy in Beijing set up a special fast track program for Chinese citizens to travel to Greenland.

Control of Greenland will be incredibly important in the next world-wide conflagration, as the island will play a major role in control of the Arctic and the Atlantic. One of NORAD's main intelligence and surveillance facilities is Thule Air Base, located on Greenland's west coast.

Moreover, Greenland possesses a wealth of "rare earth minerals" that are essential to many high-tech applications, including U.S. military weapons systems. And communist China has cornered the market on these essential minerals.

Our current president has been sleepwalking for the past four years. Our president-elect is smarter than virtually all of his critics. He wants peace, but he knows we must get a lot stronger and show communist China that we are not pushovers. That's why Donald Trump is bringing up these issues.

Protecting Pro-life Policies

When President-elect Trump announced Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., as his nominee for secretary of Health and Human Services, many in the pro-life community were concerned because Kennedy's position on abortion is nuanced at best.

But we knew Trump wasn't going to abandon the pro-life positions he implemented in his first term, and there was no way he would appoint someone to a key position who would actively undermine the sanctity of life.

We got proof last week, although it didn't get much attention.

During Kennedy's meetings on Capitol Hill, pro-life senators are raising important issues with him. Sen. <u>Josh Hawley</u>, a stalwart pro-life conservative, described his meeting with Kennedy in a series of online posts. He wrote:

"Today I got to sit down with Robert Kennedy, Jr... He committed to me to reinstate President Trump's pro-life policies at HHS. That includes reinstating the Mexico City policy & ending taxpayer funding for abortions domestically. He supports reinstating the bar on Title X funds going to organizations that promote abortion.

"He ... also said all of his deputies at HHS would be pro-life. He told me he believes there are far too many abortions in the US and that we cannot be the moral leader of the free world with abortion rates so high.

"RFK also pledged to reinstate conscience protections for healthcare providers."

In a broad sense, Robert K. Kennedy's appointment is important because of his commitment to reforming the American medical system. He believes too many of us are dying too early because of bad policies set by multinational corporations that are invested in us not being healthy.

Taking Faith Seriously

In a recent interview with *Fox News*, Cardinal <u>Timothy Dolan</u>, the archbishop of New York, said that his recent conversations with Donald Trump have led him to believe that Trump "takes his Christian faith seriously."

Dolan added, "I think the assassination attempts kind of renewed in him." Trump has expressed such sentiments himself in recent months. (Here and here.)

In related news, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu expressed his deep appreciation for Israel's Christian supporters. In a Christmas message, Netanyahu said:

"My dear Christian friends, as you gather with your family and friends this Christmas, I wish the Christian community in Israel and around the world blessings for a Merry Christmas from the Holy Land.

"At a time when Israel is fighting on seven fronts, we deeply appreciate the steadfast support of our Christian friends around the world. You've stood by our side, you've stood by our side resiliently, consistently, forcefully as Israel defends our civilization against barbarism...

"Israel leads the world in fighting the forces of evil and tyranny, but our battle is not yet over. With your support, and with God's help, I assure you, we shall prevail. From Jerusalem, city of peace, I wish you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year."

DONALD TRUMP IS TIME MAGAZINE'S PERSON OF THE YEAR

President-elect Donald J. Trump, who has both derided Time magazine and pined for its approval, was named the publication's person of the year on Thursday.

Mr. Trump also received the title in 2016, after his first presidential election victory, and now joins a group of 16 people who have been chosen more than once. The club includes the last three two-term presidents: Bill Clinton, George W. Bush and Barack Obama. (Franklin D. Roosevelt is the only person to have been given the title three times.)

Sam Jacobs, Time's editor in chief, wrote in the magazine that the choice was not a difficult one: "On the cusp of his second presidency, all of us — from his most fanatical supporters to his most fervent critics — are living in the Age of Trump."

Mr. Trump, who rang the opening bell at the New York Stock Exchange on Thursday morning, has had a tempestuous relationship with Time. After being named person of the year in 2016, he described the magazine as a "very important" publication and said it had granted him a "tremendous honor."

All-Time Worsts

With his pardon of Hunter, Joe Biden has cemented his status as one of our very worst presidents. Not do be outdone, Newsom is pressing his case for our all-time worst governor. He's now convened a "Special Session" seeking \$25 million to "Trump-proof" California.

In pledging to protect "California values," Newsom apparently is aiming to protect our national lead in gas prices, housing costs, taxes, homelessness, poverty, crime, or illegal border crossings. He won't succeed. In the House, I'll use every possible tool to Newsom-proof our state.

The 2025-2026 Budget California's Fiscal Outlook

Forecast Multiyear State Budget Deficit Overview of the Legal Analyst Office - "Annual Fiscal Outlook"

In anticipation of the January 10 release of the Governor's 2025-2026 proposed budget.

The Fiscal Outlook's purpose is to project a baseline estimate of the budget before new policies or economic forecasts from the Governor. It identifies the budget's size and direction and gives the legislature the fiscal context of 2025-2026.

Anticipated Deficits

2025-2026: 2 billion dollars 2026-202:7 20 billion dollars 2027-2028 27 billion dollars 2028-2029 29 billion dollars current spending is at approximately 3.5%

*Remember that projected budgets are generally in deficit and corrected before the budget year

Revenue is slightly up due to an uptake in the stock market, which increased upper taxpayer taxes. However, this is not an indicator of the economy improving.

State spending has accelerated beyond budget expectations but will not lead to a budgetary crisis for 2025-2026.

Future spending is expected at 6%, with revenue growth expected at 4%.

*Reasons for Expenses

In-Home Health Care - Programs expanded for the aging population = increased Medical spending 2023 health care minimum wage increase went into effect


State Economy - Under performance = Employment has not grown in 18 months; Government and healthcare employment has increased; Consumer spending is down; Business owner income is down

Federal Influences on the Economy - Expected increase in international trade – tariffs; Expected immigration enforcement will limit the labor market; Expected decreased funding for Medi-Care will lead to increased funding from the state.

Monetary Policy - If interest rate cutting stops, it will negatively affect the economy.

The challenge is to reconcile outpacing spending trends with modest revenue growth. 2024 Spring Legislature and the Administration reduced expenditures through reduction, delays in payments, borrowing, shifting, and deferrals.
