Topic: Marin Pension Unfunded Liabilities – What Can Citizens Do Now?

Paul Premo is a 52-year resident of Mill Valley. He worked with Chevron for 27 years, first as a Chemical Engineer (Masters from MIT) and then in management and executive positions in finance, regulatory matters, and as Secretary and Treasurer of Chevron USA. Paul retired early from Chevron and has been consulting on energy and regulatory matters for 20+ years. He served on the Marin Civil Grand Jury as foreperson pro-tem for its 2012-2013 term.

Premo has been a core group member of Citizens for Sustainable Pension Plans since 2014, and frequently comments on related pension issues in letters to editors and in comments and testimony before local governments and concerned citizens groups.

He is the taxpayer representative on the Citizens Oversight Committee of Transportation Authority of Marin, a member of MUTA (Marin United Taxpayers Association), and a core group member of the newly formed Citizens for Sensible Taxation - Marin.

Paul Premo will answer your questions on this very serious Marin issue of unfunded pension liabilities and how the citizens can effect change to the Marin government's flagrant debt spending.
