**Speaker:
John Cox, 2018 Candidate for California Governor**



Conservative Republican John Cox is an attorney, C.P.A. and millionaire venture capitalist who has announced his run to become governor of California. Raised by a single mom, his biography is fascinating. On social media, John describes himself as a businessman, government reform advocate and a Jack Kemp-style Republican. He has, in the past 35 years, established and built four businesses which now employ over 100 people and have assets of over \$200 million. He moved to California in 2008.

In addition to running for Governor, Mr. Cox is mounting a new initiative to restore the balance of power to citizens in California. He is the driving force behind an amendment to the California state constitution called the California Citizens Legislature Initiative. Its aim is to redrawn all the legislative districts in the state, subdividing them so as to dramatically increase local citizen participation in government.

Cox is on the San Diego USO board, works with the San Diego Restorative Justice Mediation Project, and is a member of the Lincoln Club.

Cox was active in the Illinois Republican Party prior to moving to California. He mounted campaigns in the early part of the last decade against incumbents for an Illinois U.S. Congressional seat and a Senate seat.
