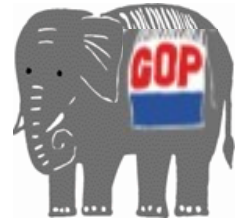

Jonathan Madison, an attorney with the firm Fried & Williams LLP, is a busy guy. In 2014 he ran for State Assembly as the Republican candidate from the 22nd District, only three years after graduating Magna Cum Laude from Howard University. He obtained his law degree from the University of San Francisco School of Law in 2016, having clerked for both Fried & Williams and the Wells Fargo Legal Group. His expertise is in estate planning, residential and commercial real estate transactions, and financial services.

In addition to his law practice, Jonathan is a California Republican Party Delegate. He also finds the time to write regular opinion columns in Bay Area newspapers, including the San Francisco Chronicle and the San Mateo Daily Journal.
