Fresno Mayor Ashley Swearingin

Candidate – State Controller

The Controller is the State's Chief Financial Officer and watchdog of the Treasury; deciding vote on the Board of Equalization & Franchise Tax Board; has authority to audit every state agency and program; on the Board of Directors for both CalPERS and CalSTRS and a member of the State Lands Commission and 80 other boards.

In 2008, Ashley Swearingin was elected Mayor of Fresno campaigning on four "priority issues": Jobs and Education; Safe, Quality Neighborhoods; Effective and Responsible Government and Regional Leadership. She defeated her opponent 54% to 45%. She was re-elected in 2012 to a second term with 75% of the vote, defeating four other candidates.

Prior to becoming Mayor of Fresno, in 2000 Mrs. Swearingin was Director of Community and Economic Development at Cal State University Fresno. In 2002 she co-founded the Regional Jobs Initiative, an industry-focused effort aimed at helping the unemployment in Fresno County. In 2005 she became lead executive for the California Partnership for the San Joaquin Valley and serves as Deputy Chair of the Partnership Board of Directors.

Mrs. Swearingin was born in Texas, raised in Arkansas and moved with her family to Fresno in 1987. She received her BS and MBA from California State University Fresno. She and her husband, Paul, have two children.
