Bill Whalen is a research fellow at the Hoover Institution, where he studies and writes on current events and political trends, with an emphasis on California opinion makers including the Los Angeles Times, Sacramento Bee and the San Francisco Chronicle, as well as the Washington Post and the Wall Street Journal.

He can be seen and heard on Bay Area radio and television, commenting on current events.

Bill also serves as a media consultant for California political hopefuls and aspiring policy leaders. His clients have included Arnold Schwarzenegger, Tom Campbell and former Los Angeles Mayor Dick Riordan.

From 1994 to 1999, Bill was the chief speechwriter and director of public affairs for former California Governor Pete Wilson. In that capacity, he was responsible for the governor's annual State of the State address, as well as all major policy addresses.

A native of Washington, D.C., where he was a political correspondent for Insight Magazine, the national newsweekly of the Washington Times. He was also honored for his profiles and analyses of Campaigns, Congress and the White House. During that time he appeared frequently on C-SPAN, NPR, and CNBC.
