Distinguished Guest Speaker Colonel Christopher C. Starling, USMC (Ret) National Security Challenges for the Next President

Colonel Chris Starling is the Executive Director of NPower SkillBridge, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that moves active duty service members from defending the nation to protecting the network. Members of the Armed Forces can recieve cyber security training at no cost before they leave the military, enabling them to land highly critical and highly lucrative cybersecurity jobs in the civilian sector. Graduates work at Raytheon, Booz Allen Hamilton, General Dynamics, BAE Systems, Deloitte, the National Security Agency, and more.

During 26 years on active duty in the Marine Corps, Chris completed 10 overseas deployments, including three combat tours in the Middle East. He was an instructor at the US Military Academy at West Point NY and spent a year studying China's expanding influence in Africa for a year as a Hoover Fellow at Stanford University.

Chris completed his undergraduate education at Virginia Military Institute and his Masters in Public Administration from the City University of New York. He is also a graduate of the Joint Forces Staff College.

Colonel Starling will discuss the threats that are facing our country and our current levels of readiness across the Armed Forces. What are the existential threats to America? Is terrorism tamped down enough so we don't have to worry about it? How do our allies view us? How do our adversaries view us? How is warfare changing and what are we learning from Russia's stalled invasion of Ukraine? Is China's military all that it is purported to be? Will Iran have a nuclear weapon soon? Is Kim Jong Un really cuckoo for Cocoa Puffs? How does the situation in Gaza impact the United States?

Bring your questions, the good, the bad and the ugly; and let's have a lively discussion about national security priorities for our next president.
