Debbie Bacigalupi is a California cattle rancher who is an educational/keynote speaker on United Nations Agenda 21 Sustainable Development, the 2030 Agenda/The Business 2030 Agenda, Cap and Trade, "Sustainable Development", the Green New Deal, radical environmentalism vs conservation, property rights, the destruction of dams and water rights, Agriculture in the Classroom, and other related important, pertinent Constitutional issues.

To gain a better understanding of where the world is heading, over the past decade, Ms. Bacigalupi has attended many influential conferences like the 2012 United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, 2015 COP21 UN Paris Climate Change Conference (UNFCCC), 2017 EcoCities World Summit in Melbourne, Australia, Navigating the American Carbon World on Cap and Trade (San Francisco, 2017), the Western Governors Association Crucial Habitat Conferences (2016/2017), and many Fish and Wildlife meetings and hearings on the Endangered Species Act. In August 2019, Ms. Bacigalupi attended the first "major" UN conference in the USA. Ms. Bacigalupi awaits approval to attend the upcoming 2019 United Nations Framework on Climate Change (COP25) world conference in Santiago, Chile, where the growing number of youth and the Green New Deal are sure to take center stage.

Ms. Bacigalupi co-produced and inspired timely documentaries: Blue, No Water No Farmer No Food, and Wolves in Government Clothing - all focusing on how aggressive environmental policy is harming rural America. Recently, Ms. Bacigalupi created a scholarship fund for youth taking on Agenda 21 in their own community (https://www.gofundme.com/f/the-agenda-21-challenge).

Discouraged by the erosion of rural America, she ran for the U.S. House of Representatives in 2012. Ms. Bacigalupi holds a BS degree in Business and a Masters in Business Administration and is a Certified Meeting Professional and Sommelier.
