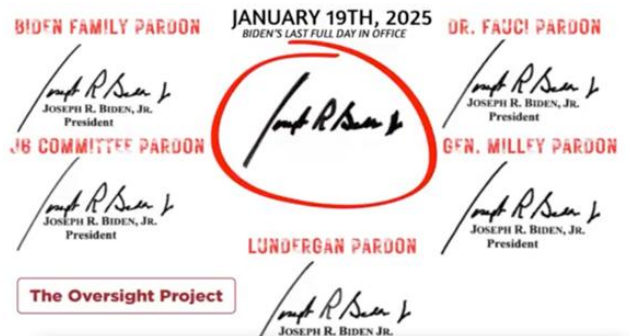
The sad and disturbing aspect of

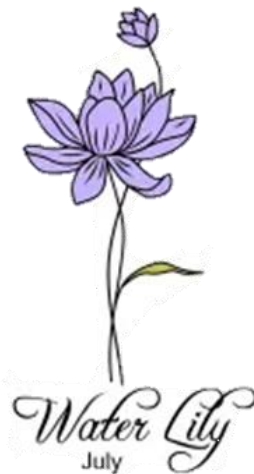
JULY MEETING
